Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF) Model





SPF Model: Action Areas

Assessment: community needs & readiness

Capacity: coalition mobilization

Planning: action plan

Implementation: comprehensive strategies (7)

Evaluation: processes and desired outcomes

Sustainability & Cultural Competence: continual application to entire SPF model



Types of Prevention

Primary: prevention that takes place before drug use is initiated (up stream). (general population/universal prevention; or targeted groups who are at increased risk/selective prevention)

Secondary: promotes safety for those who already use alcohol and other drugs.

Tertiary: involves interventions to prevent the progression of established substance abuse before it has negative health consequences (downstream).



7 Strategies for Environmental Change

Provide Information: presentations (booths)

Enhancing Skills: training (webinars)

Providing Support: referral for service (partners)

Enhancing Access/Reducing Barriers: to services

Changing Consequences: rewards or citations

Changing Physical Design: signage (lighting)

Policy Change: creating or enhancing written procedures


